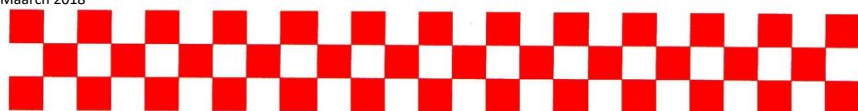

# COMPLETE SOW CHOW Code 2360



Feed Purina **COMPLETE SOW CHOW** according to the following table:

	COMPLETE SOW CHOW kg/head/day
GILT DEVELOPMENT:	
Individually fed	2.0-2.4
Group fed	2.3-2.8
FLUSHING:	
Gilts and Sows	Increase feeding up to 3 kg/per sow/ per day for three days following weaning
GESTATION	
Gilts - Individually Fed	2.0-2.2
Gilts - Group Fed	2.3-2.8
Sows - Individually Fed	1.8-2.2
Sows - Group Fed	2.1-2.5
Increase feed intake by 0.5 to 1.0 kg/head/day during the last 2 to 3 weeks of gestation. Five days prior to farrowing, gradually reduce feed intake to 1.5 kg/head/day.	
LACTATION: During first week of lactation increase feed to 5 kg/ head/day. Seven days post farrowing, sows with more than 8 piglets should be on full feed. Reduce feed by 0.5 kg /piglet/day to sows nursing less than 7 piglets.

Clarence Farm Services Ltd. recommends you follow these management practices:

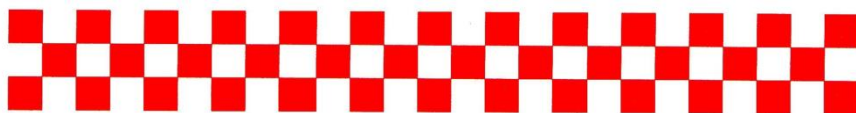
1. Provide a source of clean, fresh water at all times.
2. Any ration change should be made gradually.
3. Provide fresh feed daily and prevent feed from accumulating and mould development in feeders.
4. Provide adequate space in a draft-free, clean, dry and well ventilated environment.
5. Provide warm, draft free quarter with clean, dry sleeping area for sows and litter.

Consult your veterinarian for recommended health programs for your local area. This includes internal and external parasites.
