## **GOAT CHOW**

#### Code 1199

Feed Purina **GOAT CHOW** to your goats according to the following directions:

- 1. A good quality calf milk replacer can be used as a substitute for goat or cow's milk.
- 2. At one week feed Purina **GOAT CHOW** free choice.
- 3. After four months of age, feed growing goats Purina **GOAT CHOW** at a rate of 0.7 to 1 kg. per head per day.
- 4. During lactation, one kg of **GOAT CHOW** should be fed for every 2 kg. of milk produced.
- 5. Feed dry does 1.5 kg. GOAT CHOW per head per day.
- 6. Bucks will require 1-1.5 kg. of **GOAT CHOW** per day.
