Clarence Farm Services Ltd. recommends you follow these management practices:

- Provide a source of clean, fresh water. It can be supplied as well water, natural streams and ponds or snow in extensive grazing systems.
- 2. For most roughage programs, provide the appropriate Purina mineral plus plain salt free-choice. Minerals should be provided in sheltered feeders.
- 3. Clean feeders frequently.
- 4. Consult your veterinarian for a recommended herd health program.
