

Clarence Farm Services Ltd. recommends you follow these management practices:


1. Provide a source of clean, fresh water and adequate drinking space per animal at all times.
2. Feed according to body size, and body condition.
3. Provide a draft free pen with clean, dry sleeping area.
4. When using a self-feeder, make sure it is adjusted to minimize feed wastage.
5. Feed should be well managed, so as to provide adequate feeder space and prevent moisture condensation, mould and insect development.
6. Consult your veterinarian for recommended health programs for your local area.

These recommendations are intended as a guide. They should be adjusted to variables of management, environment and individual needs.
