Feed **CFS Horse Chow Checkers** in conjunction with water and a minimum of 1% body weight (on a dry matter basis) of a long-stemmed forage (hay/pasture). Feed according to the following table. The lower quantity meets minimum vitamin and mineral requirements, and the higher quantity meets Superior recommendations. Ideally, feed enough to achieve desired body condition. For every kilogram under the Superior recommendation, provide 200 grams of **CFS Elevate** (3573). Depending on hay analysis, and/or age of horses, **CFS Select** (3571) may be better suited as the ideal top-dress supplement.

OPTIMIZE YOUR HORSE'S DIET

Clarence Farm Services Ltd. recommends analyzing your hay and balancing the ration accordingly.

Feed clean, dust free hay in sufficient amount daily. Feeding poor quality hay or feeding inadequate amounts could cause colic and other digestive upsets.

Offer source of salt (NaCl) daily as well as plenty of fresh and clean water at all times.

Make any feed change gradually over a 7 to 10 days period.

Daily ration should be divided into 2 and preferably 3 separate feedings or more.

Use a scale to weigh your feed, so you know exactly how much your horse is being fed. Do not feed by volume.

Clarence Farm Services Ltd. recommends providing a maximum of 0.5% of body weight of this feed at one time.

These recommendations are intended as a guide. They should be adjusted to variables of management, environment and individual needs.
